

QUARTERLY ACTIVITY REPORT

For the Period of January 1 to March 31, 2023

This document provides an overview of the 3rd quarter of operations of the <u>Abuse-Free Sport</u> program and its different components, including key activities and available statistics of the <u>Office of the Sport Integrity Commissioner</u> (OSIC).

GENERAL ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

- Signed <u>service agreements</u> with an additional 38 federally-funded sport organizations (totalling 75 as of March 31, 2023)
- Initiated the first review cycle of the <u>Safe Sport Education Accreditation Program</u> (anticipated completion by April 30, 2023)
- Funded 9 research projects (totalling \$512,826) through the Safe Sport Research Grant Program
- Provided services of the OSIC to 7 provincial/territorial delegations and of the Canadian Sport Helpline to all participants during the 2023 Canada Winter Games. These services were also provided to the host society and 1 delegation during the 2023 Arctic Winter Games
- Participated in a number of sport sector events (e.g., Sport for Life Summit 2023, 2023 Canada Winter Games, Japan Sports Arbitration Agency Annual Conference, Canadian Academy of Sport and Exercise Medicine [CASEM] Annual Symposium)

OSIC ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

- Published several informational resources, including: <u>UCCMS Consent Form FAQ</u>, <u>Mental Health Tips</u>
 & Strategies, NDA and Confidentiality FAQ, Interactive Complaint Management Process Flowchart
- Participated as witness to the studies of the House of Commons (i) Standing Committee on the Status of Women regarding Women & Girls in Sport and (ii) Standing Committee on Canadian Heritage regarding Safe Sport in Canada
- Welcomed 3 new staff members

OSIC QUARTERLY STATISTICS

- 155 safe sport related inquiries received by the <u>Canadian Sport Helpline</u>
- 48 new <u>Complaints/Reports</u> received by the OSIC
- **38%** (18 of 48) of Complaints/Reports within <u>jurisdiction and authority</u>); 1 of 48 with determination pending
- 100% of Complaints/Reports within jurisdiction and authority accepted by the OSIC
- 5 active cases with <u>Provisional Measures</u> in effect on March 31, 2023
- 3 Sport Environment Assessments at or beyond the scoping phase as of March 31, 2023
